Solenoid Fuses July 29, 2021

We would like to inform you that all Linea PB, Strada EE, Strada EP, and Strada MP now have fuses protecting the electronic board in case of a short of the auto-fill or hot water solenoid valves. The fuses are easily reachable from the front panel of the electronics box and each of them is identified by an "F1".

Inside the electronics box, the cables that go to the fuse/fuse holders are marked "tea" (the one connecting to the hot water solenoid valve) and "fill" (the one connecting to the auto-fill solenoid valve). Both fuses are connected to the live wire so that they can disconnect the electronic board from the solenoid in case of excessive current.



This improvement was first introduced in the Strada AV, subsequently adopted in the Leva and the newborn KB90, and has now been extended to the previously mentioned models, starting from the following serial numbers:

Linea PB: PB015746
Strada EE: ST003791
Strada MP: ST003750
Strada EP: ST003792
Strada EP 1gr: ST003784

The two fuses, which are used for the pump at the terminal block as well, can be ordered using part number E.2.003.
